



ASHRAE Montreal 2024 Bursaries

The Montreal Chapter continues its mission to support the next generation of professionals in the field of building engineering by awarding, through its foundations, four (4) scholarships to deserving students. Two of these scholarships (\$1250 each) come from the ASHRAE Montreal Foundation, and the other two (\$750 each) from ASHRAE Montreal Student Activities. University students in building engineering (Concordia, ÉTS, Polytechnique, McGill and Université de Sherbrooke) and CEGEP students in building technology (building engineering) (Ahuntsic, Vanier and St-Hyacinthe, Trois-Rivières) can participate. Winners will be ranked from first to fourth place. First and second place will win \$1250 each, and third and fourth place will win \$750 each.

Eligibility criteria for the scholarships are as follows:

- - **Financial requirements;**
- **Involvement of the candidate** in the field of building engineering;
- **Quality of cover letter;**
- **Academic results;**
- **Continuation of studies** in the same program the following semester, i.e. not yet graduating from a university program. For CEGEP students, not graduating unless continuing in the same field of study at the bachelor's level.

You will need to submit the following documents:

- - Cover letter signed or electronically authorized by you and your institution's ASHRAE professor (Student Advisor);
- Your most recent transcript (including Fall 2023);
- Curriculum Vitae;
- Photo of yourself (can be sent before May 6 for presentation of winners).
